

CLEANING JOINERY

Simply cleaning exterior joinery is the first important operation required for correct maintenance. Phenomena such as acid rain and atmospheric pollution, in the form of dusts deposited on joinery, really test a coating film's resistance to deterioration. Annual cleaning removes all deposits built up. This easy operation allows the coating film to last longer and is an excellent anti-aging aesthetic treatment. Also, during this regular cleaning you can check if the coating film has suffered any accidental damage and carry out any retouching necessary.

Do not use aggressive detergents such as alcohol- or ammonia-based ones for cleaning. Such products would break down the coating film and damage it, shortening its lifetime. Use neutral detergents, such as Sayerlack Linea Blu **HH 8011** or **HT 8011** for excellent surface cleaning without harming the coating film. Use a soft cloth both to distribute the cleaning product and to dry the surface.
